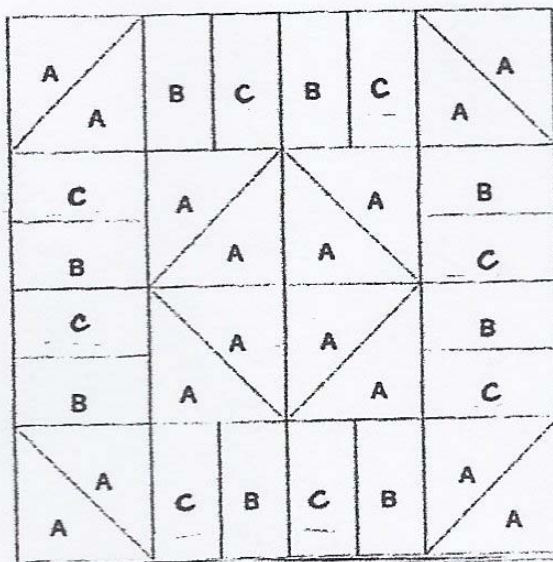
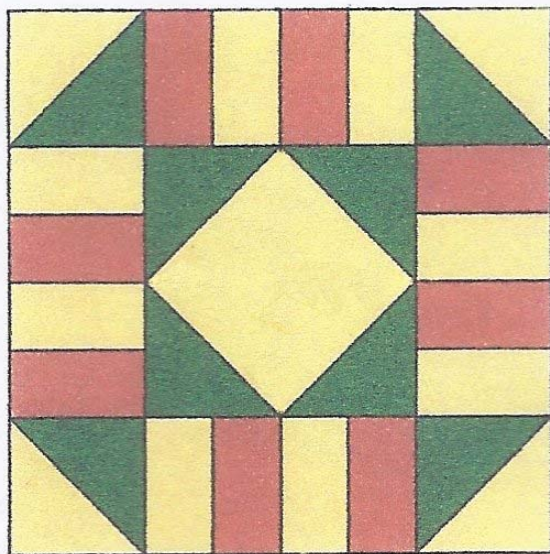


MUDSOCK Quilters Guild Block

Cross Roads by Nancy Cabot

Colors: Rust for Mudsock
Green for Continuity and Renewal of Quilting
Gold for the value of Friendship among Quilters



Finished Size	Qty	9"	8"	6"	4"
Gold	A – 4 each	3 1/8"	2 7/8"	2 3/8"	1 7/8"
Green	A – 4 each	3 1/8"	2 7/8"	2 3/8"	1 7/8"
Rust	B – 8 each	1 5/8" X 2 3/4"	1 1/2" X 2 1/2"	1 1/4" X 2"	1" X 1 1/2"
Gold	C – 8 each	1 5/8" X 2 3/4"	1 1/2" X 2 1/2"	1 1/4" X 2"	1" X 1 1/2"

Using the gold and green squares (A), place right sides together, draw diagonal line on the wrong side of the gold squares, sew a scant 1/4" on both sides of the diagonal line making 8 half-square triangles. Press seams to green. Set aside for corners of the block. Using 4 half-square triangles, join making a square with the gold triangles in the center. Fan Center, and press seams to the right as you turn the block. Set aside for center of the block.

Using rust (B) and gold (C) rectangles and sewing along the long sides, make 4 sets of rust, gold, rust, golds strips. Press seams to rust. Set aside for sides of the block.

Lay out units made as a nine patch with the gold half square triangles at the corners.

Sew rows 1 and 3, press seams toward center.

Sew row 2, press seams away from center.

Sew rows together, press seams away from center.
