Registration and Judging: This includes coming up with quilt categories and a registration system for quilts and participants. Also, set up for judging, writing comments on cards, making or buying ribbons, etc.

Vendors: Select group of vendors, make sure venders have enough tables, etc. This includes food vendor.

Set up/Tear Down: Lay out plan for show, put up poles and curtains. Also will include tear down after show is over.

Programs and Demos: Come up with several programs and/or demos for both show days.

Advertising and Hospitality: Come up with inexpensive strategies for advertising. Come up with door prizes, grab bags or other things.

Mudsock Mercantile: Collect and sell items for our shop. Need pin cushions, little quilts, books, magazines, etc.
