

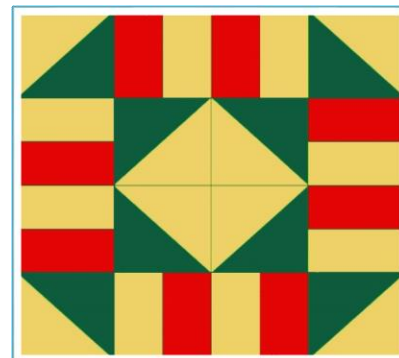

The next Mudsock Quilt Guild meeting will be on Monday, June 12 at 9:30 AM at the Community Health Pavilion at 146th Street and Cumberland Road. There will be a demonstration of paper piecing, and you are invited to stay for sewing in the afternoon. We will be making this Christmas tree in a workshop together. The attached list includes all the pieces you need for the Christmas tree, so use some of those small pieces of fabric that you have been saving to cut the pieces before you come to the meeting. The paper pattern to complete the project will be provided at the workshop.

You are welcome to stay to sew in the afternoon, even if you do not want to make the paper pieced project. Hope to see you all there.

Paper Pieced Christmas Tree

For this project you will need:

Small cutting mat (larger is OK, but you don't need a big one)

Rotary cutter

Scissors, thread, sewing machine, etc.

Prior to meeting/workshop cut the following pieces of fabric:

- #1 Brown 1 ¼ x 1 ¼
- #2 and #3 Beige 1 ¼ x 2 ¼
- #4 Green 1 ½ x 4 ¼
- #5 Green 1 ¾ x 4
- #6 Green 1 3/8 x 3
- #7 Green 1 1/8 x 2 ¼
- #8 Green 1 ¼ x 1 ¾
- #9 and #10 Beige 2 ½ x 5

Borders: Fabric of your choice 1 ¾ x 4 (two); 1 ¾ x 6 ½ (two)

You might want to bring additional fabric scraps “just in case”


Paper piecing pattern will be provided

If desired to make paper piecing easier, purchase an “Add-A-Quarter” ruler

Also bring a 3x5 card or another straight thin piece of card stock or thin ruler to use as a straight edge
