

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS (FOR ONE BLOCK)

Each Pumpkin Block Uses the following:

- 2 Orange Prints
- 1 Brown Print
- 1 Green Print
- 1 Neutral (dark or light)



Orange Print One (Outer Edges and Center Core)

- (2) 2.5" x 10.5"
- (1) 4.5" x 10.5"
- (4) 2.5" x 2.5"

Brown Print

(1) 2.5" x 2.5"

Green Print


(1) 2.5" x 5.5"


Orange Print Two (O Shape)

- (2) 2.5" x 10.5"
- (4) 2.5" x 2.5"

Neutral Print

- (6) 2.5" x 2.5"
- (1) 2.5" x 5.5"








PIECING INSTRUCTIONS


1) First take your orange and neutral 2.5" squares and draw a line up the center diagonal. This will be your sewing line. There should be 14 squares. You do NOT need to draw a line through the brown square.



2) Take your 2.5" x 10.5" pieces and your green piece. Pin your squares as seen below, and sew $\underline{\text{ON THE LINE}}$ you just drew.




2) Trim 1/4 inch away from the line you just stitched.






PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

3) Open and press your seams.




4) Take your 4.5" x 10.5" piece and repeat the steps above for one side.







PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

5) Repeat for the other side.



6) Piece your Orange Pumpkin Units together, and your stem units together. Finally add your stem/leaf to your pumpkin! <u>USE 1/4 Inch Seam Allowance</u>





Your Unfinished Block should be 12.5" square. Once pieced into a quilt it will work out to 12" square. To make a wall hanging or table topper, try adding 2.5" strips as sashing like my friend Emily did to make this darling sample!
