

Block of the Month NEWS

Disappearing Pinwheel Arrow

I found this on Jenny Doan's website, MSQC. The basic instructions are the same, however, the initial measurements are different to make a 12.5" unfinished/12" finished block.


Cut two 8" squares of white or tone-on-tone white and two 8" squares of medium to dark Batik or tone on tone print. Draw diagonal lines on both white pieces, then stack each white square with a square of Batik/print, and sew 1/4" on both sides of the center line. Cut along the line, and you will have 4 half square triangle blocks. Press, and trim them to 7" square. Assemble as Jenny does in the video to make the Pinwheel block. It will finish at 13.5" square. (see picture A)

On the next step, she has you cut the block into thirds, which in our case will be 4.5". So if you measure 2.25" from the center seam on all 4 sides and cut, each piece will be 4.5" square. Follow the rest of her instructions for rearranging and assembly, and you will have a very cool block that looks like this!! (see picture B)


