
Mudsock May 2018 BOM

Fibonacci /Op Art Block


Fabric: 14" square of bright white solid fabric 14" square of solid black fabric Makes two blocks




- 1. Layer blocks on top of each other
- 2. Starting from left cut strips in this order: 2(1"),1.5", 2", 3.5 and 4.5" sizes, discard extra.




3. Separate into two sets with alternating black and white. Keep in same order.



- Sew strips together into two striped blocks. Try for accurate ¼ seam allowance. Press seams open.
 Be gentle when handling to reduce stretching.
- Stack these two striped blocks with narrow stripes running horizontally across top of both blocks.Square up left edge.
 - Cut from left to right strips same sizes as previous cuts: 2(1), 1.5",2.0",3.5" and 4.5"





- Again, separate into two blocks with alternating black and white
- 8. Sew blocks together. Press seams in one direction or open. Trim width to 10.5 inches
