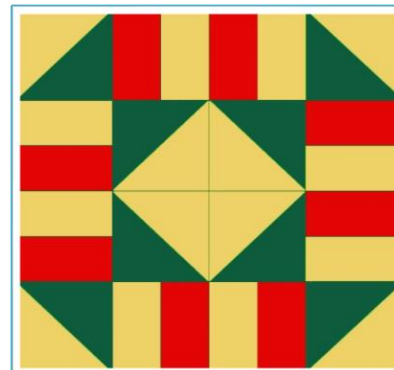

Program Committee Updates

November Meeting and Workshop: Heather Givans, owner of Crimson Tate, a quilt shop in Indianapolis and a fabric and pattern designer will present a lecture and trunk show at our November meeting. Since Heather is a high-profile speaker/local celebrity, we have invited members of the Common Threads Quilt Guild and the Indianapolis Modern Quilt Guild to join us. Visitors will be asked to pay a \$5 fee for the presentation. If you have not heard her speak before you will not want to miss this. She is a vivacious, fun and very creative young woman. She will bring some items for sale after the meeting.

On November 12th, Heather Givans will present a three hour workshop in the afternoon starting at 1:30, at the Community Health Pavilion on 146th Street. The workshop is focused on her pattern, Footnote*. Sign up for the workshop at the October meeting and bring a check or cash for the \$25. There are just six spots in the workshop remaining. If you do not have the pattern for the Footnote*, Heather will bring them for purchase on the day of the workshop. There is a template you will need, but you can make that from plastic versus purchasing a template. If you want to visit her shop in advance to talk through fabric choices, that might be fun. Heather indicated that in the three hour workshop, it is likely that each participant will finish several blocks.
