

Sweetheart Chain

(*We used Marcia's pattern, but made it smaller than her original size)

Preparing and sewing the block:

From a color of your choice:

Cut 25-- 1.25"x1.25" squares

From Black:

Cut 1--1.25"x7.25" rectangle

Cut 7--1.25"x6.25" rectangles

Cut 4--1.25"x5.25" rectangles

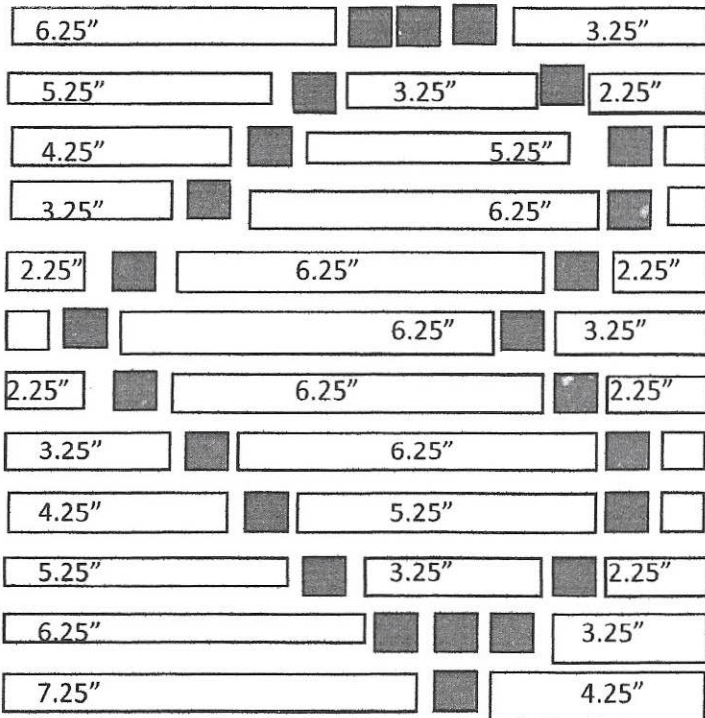
Cut 3--1.25"x4.25" rectangles

Cut 7--1.25"x3.25" rectangles

Cut 6--1.25"x2.25" rectangles

Cut 5--1.25"x1.25" squares

Piece them in this order to form each block, using very consistent $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.



The unmarked squares are 1.25"x1.25"

Sew each of the rectangles together to form a row. Then sew each row together to complete the block.
