CAKE LAYERS - COLORS OF YOUR CHOICE

Cut 1 of each Color

A - 2 ½ x 2 ½

B - 2 ½ x 4 ½

C - 2 ½ x 6 ½

D - 2 ½ x 8 ½

E - 2 ½ x 10 ½

BACKGROUND - WHITE

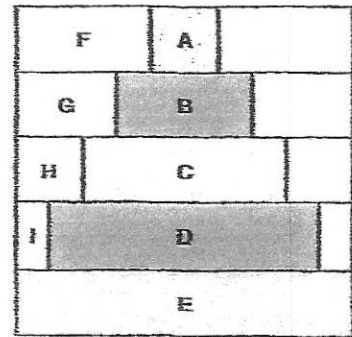
Cut a 2 ½" x 24" from this strip
subcut 2 of each of the following.

F - 2 ½ x 4 ½

G - 2 ½ x 3 ½

H - 2 ½ x 2 ½

I - 2 ½ x 1 ½



Completing the Block

Row 1. Sew F rectangles on each end of "A" square as shown in diagram.

Row 2. Sew G rectangle to each end of "B" strip.

Row 3. Sew H square on each end of "C" strip.

Row 4. Sew I rectangle to each end of "D" strip.

NOTE: Press all seams before sewing your cake layers together.

Row 5. Arrange and stitch together each strip in the following order:

A-F, B-G, C-H, D-I unit with the "E" rectangle as shown in the diagram.
