

**Sewing Machine Applique'  
Block of the Month

Finished Block Size: 12" x 16"

**ANY COLOR BE CREATIVE**

**Great way to use your Jelly Roll Scraps.**

**Materials:**

Fabrics for Sewing Machine 5 – 2 ½" x 11" strips

Background Fabric – 12" x 16"

Small pieces of Fabric for Thread Spool, (wheel-optional) and other enhancements for your sewing machine BOM.

Fusible Web (Lite EZ-Steam II) or your choice

Sew your 2 ½" x 11" strips together and press. Using the Templates for Sewing Machine, Thread Spool and (wheel-optional), follow instructions for the fusible web in drawing your shapes.

**Note: Reverse the Sewing Machine template on the fusible web when drawing it.**

Cut out the drawn shapes. Finger press your Sewing Machine and Spool to the background fabric.

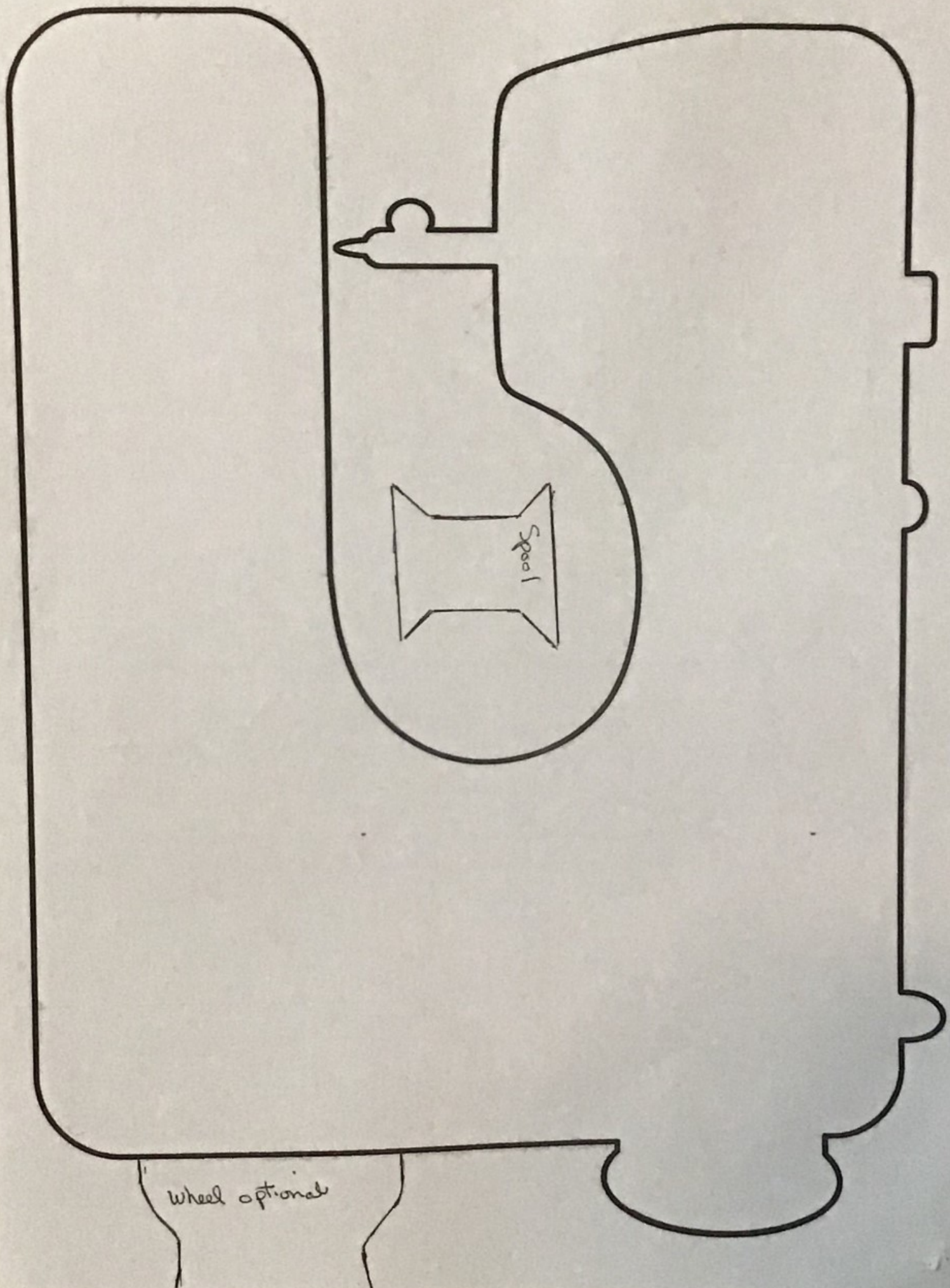
To permanently bond the appliqué press the pieces with iron.

Sew using your preferred stitching method.

**SUGGESTED ENHANCEMENTS:** You can Appliqué a heart on the right side of the sewing machine making it look like a pin cushion. Change the wheel on the sewing machine, by cutting out a different color of fabric and appliqué it on background fabric. There are many ways of enhancing your machine but remember best not to use buttons.

**NOTE:** There will be a picture of the sample block along with the pattern posted on the Mudsock Quilter Guild website.
