

**MUDSOCK QUILTERS GUILD BLOCK
BLOCK OF THE MONTH
DECEMBER 2019**

Pattern: Cross Roads by Nancy Cabot
Revised for BOM by Sally Sandilands

NOTE: BLOCK WILL NOT BE DONE IN THE TRADITIONAL MUDSOCK COLORS.

COLORS TO BE USED: White on White and Two Colors of your choice.

FINISHED SIZE: 9" BLOCK See Diagrams for cutting and layout.

Fabrics Needed:

| | | |
|---------------------------------|---------------|-----------------|
| Colors: White on White | "A" - 4 each | 3 1/8" Square |
| Darker Color of your choice | "AA" - 4 each | 3 1/8" Square |
| ** Lighter Color of your choice | "B" - 8 each | 1 5/8" x 2 3/4" |
| ** White on White | "C" - 8 each | 1 5/8" x 2 3/4" |

**** NOTE: Easy way to cut Colors "B" and "C". Place right sides together and cut strip 1 5/8" x 24" long. Sew a scant 1/4" along the long sides. Press to darker side. Then cut into 8 - 2 3/4" rectangles. Now sew two rectangles together by alternating colors. NOTE: Very important to sew in order ("B", "C", "B", "C"). Make a total of 4 sets. These will be used later for the sides of the block.**

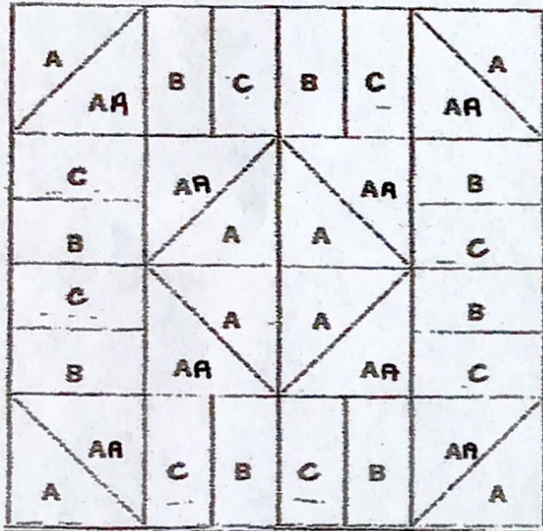
Using the White "A" and Darker Color "AA", place right sides together, draw diagonal line on the wrong side of the white squares, sew a scant 1/4" on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the center line making 8 half-square triangles. (See Diagram) Press seams to darker side and trim corners. Set aside 4 half-square triangles for corners of the block. Using 4 half-square triangles, join making a square with the white triangles in the center. Press seams to the right side. This will be your center block. (See Diagram)

Lay out units as a Nine Patch with the WHITE half-square triangles at the corners. NOTE: In all three rows be careful to alternate rectangle side panels. (See Diagram).

Sew Rows, 1 and 3, press seams toward center.

Sew Row 2, press seams away from center.

Sew Rows together, press seams away from center.
