

AIR CASTLE BLOCK

Please read through all directions before cutting.

You will need:

White fabric for background. Can be White on White.

3 fabric choices for block

FABRIC -



Background Fabric – Please use WHITE or WHITE ON WHITE

2 squares – $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " - cut once on the diagonal – corner pieces

1 square – $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " - cut twice on both diagonals

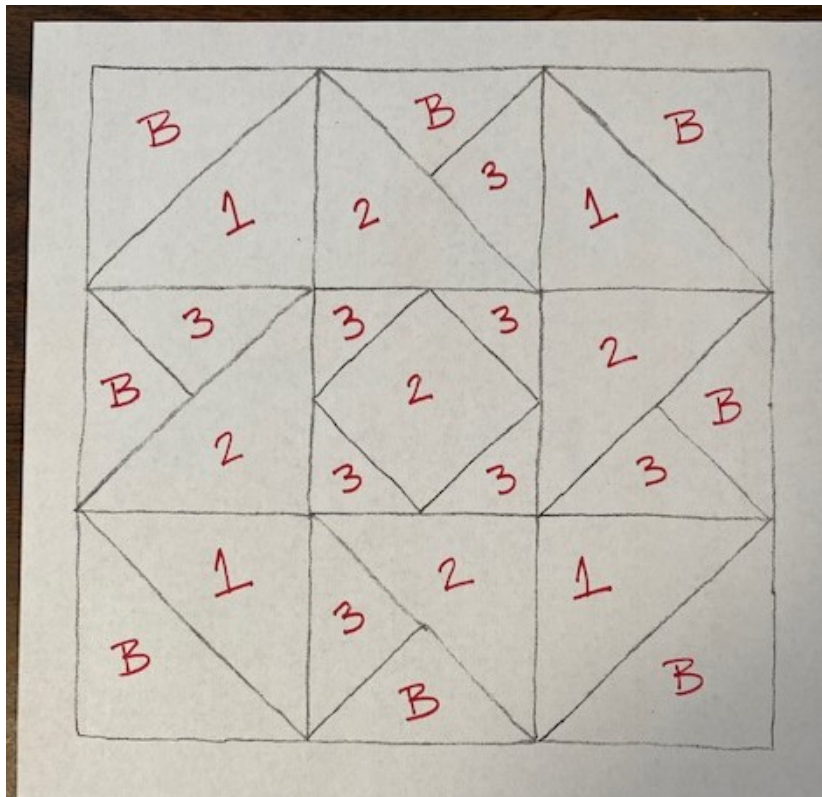
Fabric 1 – 2 squares – $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " - cut once on the diagonal – corner pieces

Fabric 2 – 1 square – $3 \frac{3}{8}$ " – this is center square

2 squares – $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " – cut once on the diagonal

Fabric 3 – 2 squares – $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " – cut once on the diagonal - for center square

1 square – $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " – cut twice on both diagonals

Directions:

(use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams)

Finished block size is 12 ½”

1. Decide what colors to use for Fabric 1 through 3 and make a note of each color.

Fabric 1 -

Fabric 3 -

Background - White



2. Make all the cuts and keep track of your colors

3. Lay out all the cuts in number order to form the block



4. Start sewing row by row – completing each separate block in the row

TOP Row -

Top left - Sew the corner half squares together – press seam

Top Middle - Connect the two quarter squares (background / Fabric 3) – press seam

then connect the now half square to the other half square – press seam

Top right – sew the corner half squares together – press seam

CONNECTING the row –

Sew the Top left square to the Top middle square – press seam

Sew the two connected squares to the Top right square – press seam

Top row is complete

MIDDLE Row –

Middle left - Connect the two quarter squares (background / Fabric 3) – press seam

then connect the now half square to the other half square – press seam

Middle Middle – Starting on opposite ends of the corner square - sew each Fabric 3 triangle onto the square. Press seams.

Now continue with the other two sides of the square. Press seams. The square will now measure 4 ½". Your square should look like this:



Middle Right - Connect the two quarter squares (background / Fabric 3) – press seam

then connect the now half square to the other half square – press seam

CONNECTING the row –

Sew the Middle left square to the Middle middle square – press seam

Sew the two connected squares to the Middle right square – press seam

Middle row is complete

BOTTOM Row –

Bottom left - Sew the corner half squares together – press seam

Bottom Middle - - Connect the two quarter squares (background / Fabric 3) – press seam

then connect the now half square to the other half square – press seam

Bottom right – sew the corner half squares together – press seam

CONNECTING the row –

Sew the Bottom left square to the Bottom middle square – press seam

Sew the two connected squares to the Bottom right square – press seam

Bottom row is complete



5. Once all three rows are done then it is time to connect them.

6. Start by sewing the top row to the middle and then adding the bottom row.

7. Press all seams

You are complete. I hope you enjoyed!
