

## 2020 Mudsock Quilt Challenge "Just Initial It!"

Since our April meeting was cancelled I will not be able to reveal this year's Challenge in person, so I have included the information in the newsletter. This year's Challenge involves your name, or at least, the initials of your name.

- A. Take the initial of your first name and match it to a guilt block with the same first letter.
- B. Take the initial of your middle name and find a color that has the same initial. You can get VERY creative here with all the names of colors out there.
- C. Take the initial of your last name and pair it with a color that has that same initial. Again, be creative, search color names online for some fun ones!

For my initials I might have: C=Crossroads J=Japanese Maple B=Burnt Umber So, that's how we choose the Block and Color, what about the rest of the parameters?

**Size**: No smaller than 12"x12" and no larger than 48" 48". Can be a quilt, a tote, a pillow, whatever you can imagine.

**Colors**: You may use a neutral for your background, be it white, cream, gray, black. You may use several shades or prints of your 2 "Initial" colors.

#### Masks are Needed!!!

Thanks to our members who sewed masks for Meals on Wheels (MOW) of Marion County! We turned in more than 260 at last count. MOW is serving over 1,000 people in this area who are homebound, not only the elderly but also many who are very critically ill. MOW continues to work with all 10 hospitals in Indy to provide medically tailored and physician-directed meals. All hospitals require their MOW drivers to wear face masks to enter pick up areas. Our quick response has allowed them to continue this vital work.

Our members also provided masks to Kindred Hospice and to St. Vincent's, Riverview, and Community Hospitals.

The need at Community Hospital is ongoing. If you would like to assist in this effort, please go to <a href="https://www.ecommunity.com/giveppe">https://www.ecommunity.com/giveppe</a>. Scroll down to "Homemade Goods," select "Homemade Masks," and enter the number of masks you think you will be able to make. You will be contacted with more information about how drop-off will work, where to go, etc. Please read all of the instructions carefully.

The pattern that we have been sewing is referred to on the internet as the Deaconess Hospital pattern. It's very easy to make. If you need elastic, email me, April Sterling, at <a href="mailto:aster6002@sbcglobal.net">aster6002@sbcglobal.net</a>, and I will put a plastic bag of elastic on my front porch for you to pick up. Each bag contains enough elastic

to make 20 masks. At this time, COVID-19 cases in Indiana are projected to peak in mid- to late April, so time is of the essence.

We have also been contacted by Rehabilitation Hospital of Indiana. They are a very large acute care inpatient rehabilitation facility located at I-465 and Michigan Road in Indianapolis. Their patients have various diagnoses including all types of brain and spinal cord Injuries, medically complex diagnoses, and much more. Their staff are in need of PPE. They are willing to pick up the masks so we would have only a central drop off at my house, 7835 Tufton St, Fishers.

As we are contacted by other institutions needing masks, we will post that information on our Facebook page.

Special thanks are due to Linda Gillespie for donating a spool of elastic, to Alice Whitaker for donating the elastic set aside for Little Dresses for Africa, and to Heather Givans at Crimson Tate for donating enough elastic for 370 masks. Additional elastic is on order so we should be able to continue to sew as many masks as you can produce. Glo Stalhut was able to acquire new, free bolts of fabric from one of her fabric distributors. She will provide the guild with three bolts of fabric that we can use for masks. This will be cut into two-yard sections that will be available for pick up at my house.

## **Block of the Month NEWS**

"Block of the Month" (BOM) is a quick and easy way to learn new piecing techniques while contributing to member quilts. Each month, the BOM Committee selects a unique block pattern which they assemble at home and bring to the guild meeting.

Everyone who wants to participate follows the same free pattern, using random fabrics with specified colorways. The following month, all of the uniform blocks are displayed, and a raffle is held to determine who gets to take home the blocks for an instant quilt. If enough members join in the fun, we might have 3-4 beneficiaries of the blocks!
