#### **Recipe from Lynn Hupp**

On the Facebook page, several expressed a desire for my Macaroni and Cheese Recipe and it was suggested that I put in the newsletter.

MACARONI AND CHEESE CASSEROLE

1 8oz. package of Macaroni
1 can of Cream of Mushroom Soup
1 small onion, minced
2 oz. jar chopped pimentos, drained
1 cup of Mayonnaise
4 cups shredded cheddar cheese
Paprika
Salt and pepper to taste

Cook macaroni and drain. Combine next 5 ingredients, plus salt and pepper and mix with the macaroni. Pour into a 2 qt. buttered baking dish. I add a little extra mayonnaise, if needed. Sprinkle with Paprika.

Bake @ 350 degrees for 30 minutes.
