

**BLOCK OF THE MONTH
SEPTEMBER, 2020**

ALL ROADS free pattern by ANGELA WALTERS/ Midnight Quilt Show

BLOCK: 12 1/2"(12" finished)

FABRIC: Cream on Cream for Background

Fall fabrics - Dark tans, browns, greens, oranges, golds, etc.

CUT: from Cream cut: (2) 4 1/2" x 6" rectangles
(2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
(2) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle strips

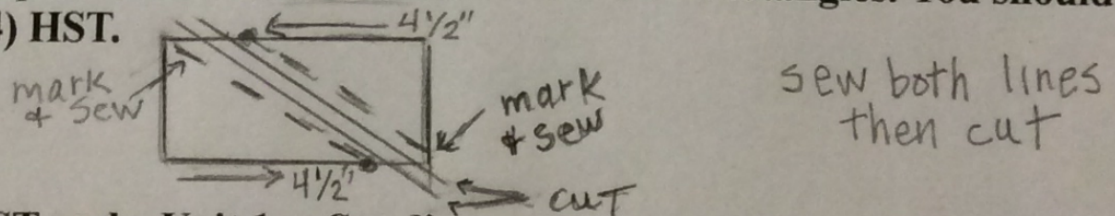
from Fall fabric cut: (2) 4 1/2" x 6" rectangles
(2) 4 1/2" squares

SEW: You will need (4) half square triangles (HST) 4 1/2" (4" finished).
Use your preferred method to make HST or try the method below
using the 4 1/2" x 6" rectangles.

1. *Pair one cream and one fall fabric 4 1/2" x 6" rectangles right sides together. From the left edge measure over 4 1/2" on the bottom edge and mark a dot. *Now mark a diagonal line from the upper left corner to the dot.

Rotate the block around and repeat, measuring and marking. See diagram

*Sew ON the marked line and cut 1/4" from your sewn line toward the center. *Repeat with the second set of 4 1/2" x 6" rectangles. You should now have (4) HST.



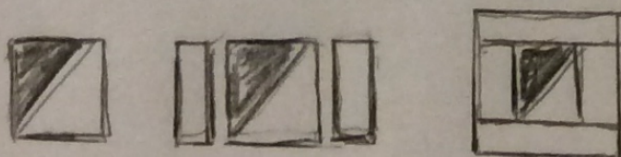
2. With one HST make Unit 1. See diagram

Important! Situate the HST with the fall color top and left.

*Add 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cream rectangles to each side of the HST.

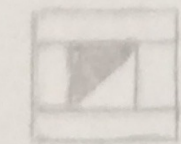
*Add 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom.

*Trim Unit 1 to 8 1/2"

Trim to 8 1/2"

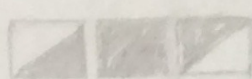
3. Assemble Units 2 and 3. Then assemble the block with the 3 units.



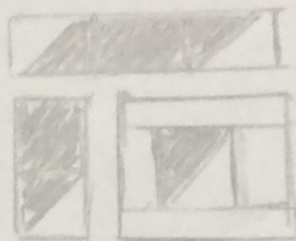
Unit 1



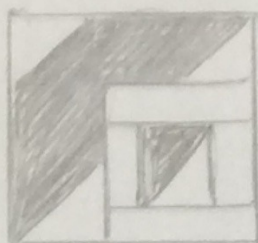
Unit 2

4. Trim your block to 12 1/2" and you're done. Make several-they're easy!
