This is a great way to use your stash scraps.

BLOCK SIZE" 8 1/2" X 13 1/2"

#### Fabric Needed:

(3) Different Colors for Jars---Your choice of colors and prints.

(3) Jar Lids-----Your choice of color, can all be the same or mix them up. Background ----White on White

Fabric A (Jar) Cut each jar from a different fabric.

Left Jar - One - 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" piece

Center Jar - One - 4 1/2" x 7 1/2" piece

Right Jar — One - 5 1/2" square

## Fabric B (Background)

Left Jar - Three - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" pieces

Two - 1 1/2" squares

Center Jar - Four - 1 1/2" squares

Right Jar - One - 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" piece

Two - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" pieces

Two - 1 1/2" squares

## Fabric C (Lid)

Left Jar – One –  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " piece

Center Jar – One – 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" piece

Right Jar - One - 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" piece

## MAKING THE BLOCKS

Make one block at a time, referring to diagrams and fabric keys. For each block, corner triangle units are made first and then the block is pieced. Pay close attention that corner triangles units are positioned the same as shown in diagrams. Press seams after each sewing step following direction of arrows in diagrams.

### LEFT JAR


 Sew two 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B squares to 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric A piece. Press.

 $B = 11/2 \times 11/2$  $A = 41/2 \times 61/2$ 


 Using <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seams, sew one 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B piece to 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric C piece. Press.



 Sew unit from step 2 between two 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B pieces. Press.




 Sew unit from step 3 to corner triangle unit from step 1. Press. Left jar block will now measure 4½" x 8½".




### CENTER JAR


 Sew two 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B squares to 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric A piece. Press.








 Using <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seams, sew 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric C piece between two 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B squares. Press.




Sew unit from step 2 to corner triangle unit from step 1. Press.
 Center jar block will now measure 4½" x 8½".




#### RIGHT JAR

A = 51/2 x 51/2

Sew two 1½" Fabric B squares to 5½"
 Fabric A square.
 Press.





Using <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seams, sew 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"
 Fabric B piece to 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"
 Fabric C piece. Press.



 Sew unit from step 3 to corner triangle unit from step 1. Press. Right jar block will now measure 5½" x 8½".



 Sew center jar block between left jar block and right jar block. Press.
