

Night & Day – Block of the Month



Size: 12” Finished

This is perfect for any fat quarter or leftover fabric

Fabric suggestions: **ONE PRINT & ONE SOLID**

There are my pictures and stock pictures listed on these directions – on the stock pictures the dark blue is the PRINT and the white are the SOLID fabrics.

Cutting Instructions

Print Fabric



... cut 1 square 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"; cut diagonally twice to make 4 quarter-square triangles.

... cut 4 rectangles 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" use **Diagram I-A** as guide for cutting 4 “one-way” half-trapezoids. (Place right side of fabric up when cutting.)

... cut 1 square 4 1/4" x 4 1/4"; cut diagonally twice to make 4 quarter-square triangles.



Solid Fabric

... cut 1 square 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"; cut diagonally twice to make 4 quarter-square triangles.

... cut 4 rectangles 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" use **Diagram I-B** as guide for cutting 4 “one-way” half-trapezoids. (Place right side of fabric up when cutting.)

... cut 1 square $4\frac{1}{4}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$; cut diagonally twice to make 4 quarter-square triangles.

Diagram 1A – **Print Fabric**

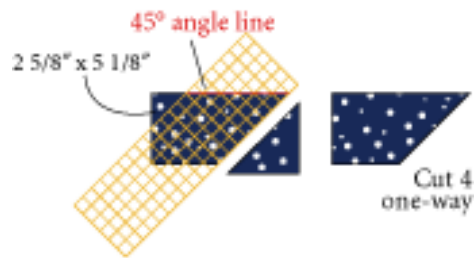
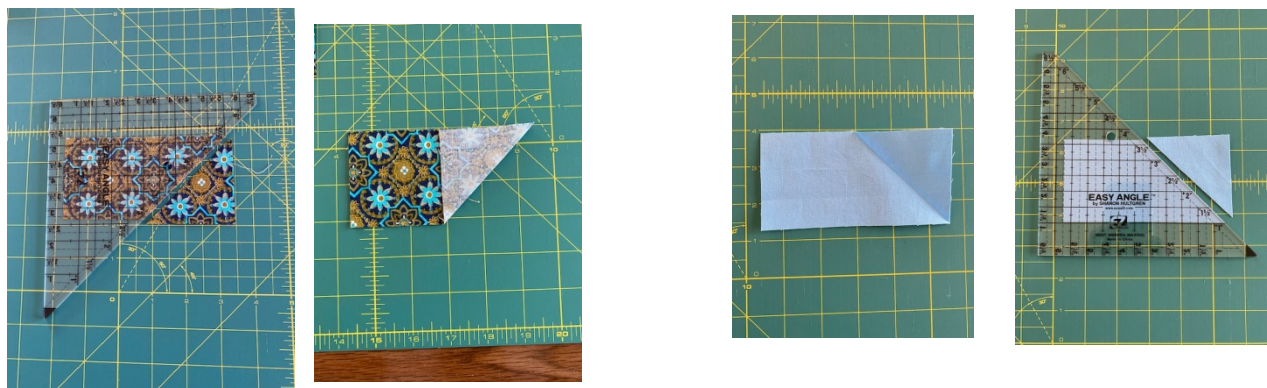


Diagram I-A

Diagram 1B – **Solid Fabric**



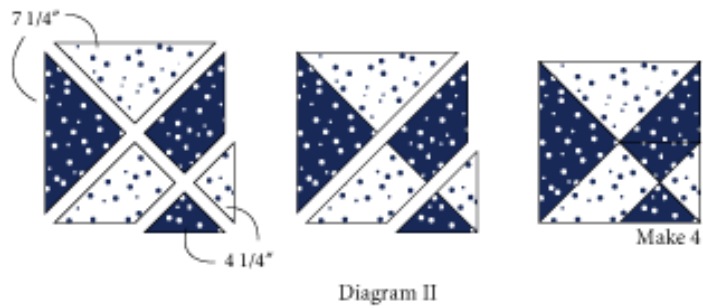
I used my Easy Angle to cut the 45 degree angle. If you do not have that ruler you can fold the corner of the fabric and press. Then use any ruler to cut along that line. Please make sure you have the correct fabric for each cut. **Print fabric is cut a different direction than the Solid fabric.** Please look at all pictures.



Assembly Instructions

Step 1. Using Diagram II as a placement guide, layout quadrant pieces and sew together. **Make 4.** Trim any edges. These measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ each

** (in this diagram II stock picture – the dark blue color is the PRINT fabric and the white color is the SOLID fabric) My picture is included to help with placement.



Step 2. Carefully turn quadrants to form Night & Day Block (see Diagram III). Sew quadrants together to make 2 rows. Sew rows together to make block
