Pretty Posy Block (9½" unfinished)



Fabric Requirements

Flower Center

[1] – 3½" square of yellow or orange (can be solid or tone on tone)

Flower Petals (any beautiful color for your flowers)

[4] - 1½" squares

[4] - 3½" squares

Leaves

[2] – 4¼" squares for the Dark Green side of the leaves

[2] – 4¼" squares for the Light Green side of the leaves


Background

[16] – 1½" squares in solid white for the background

Block Assembly Instructions


Step 1

Take the (4) - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in the color of the Flower Petals and draw a diagonal line across each as shown in the picture below. Place each $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square on the corners of the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow/orange Flower Center and sew on the diagonal line (shown in red) across each of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Trim the corners, allowing for $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. Press seams toward the center of the block as shown in the picture below. This will help with nesting the seams as you progress with the block. Square up the block to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", if needed.




Step 2

Take your (4) - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Petal squares and (8) of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares. Draw a diagonal line across each of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares as shown in the picture below. For each of the Petal squares, place (2) of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares on two adjacent corners of each Petal square and sew along the diagonal line (shown in red) across each of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares. Trim the corners, allowing for $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. Press seams toward the flower petal as shown in the picture below. Square up the block to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", if needed.




Step 3

Take your (2) - 4%" Dark Green squares and (2) 4%" Light Green squares. Place each Light Green square onto each Dark Green square. Draw a diagonal line, shown in black, and sew %" from the line, on each side of it, as shown in red. Cut along the diagonal line you drew. Press both the half square triangles open and trim them to 3%" square.



Step 4

Take your (4) completed Leaf squares and (8) of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares. Draw a diagonal line across each of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares as shown in the picture below. For each of the Leaf squares, place (2) of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares on two opposite corners and sew along the diagonal line (shown in red) across each of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares. Trim the corners, allowing for $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. Press seams towards the white corner triangles.



Step 5

Arrange the 9 patches as shown. Sew the pieces into rows and sew the rows together to make the block. Be careful to arrange your leaf blocks as shown in the photo. Press your seams as shown in the photo below. This will allow for nesting of the seams when they are joined.
