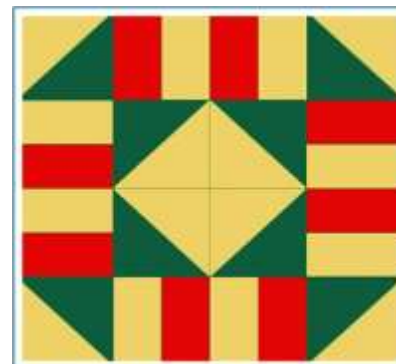

Cost: \$65 per person this covers the conference rooms for sewing and Saturday evening meal at Blue Gate. Cost **does not** include transportation or lodging.

Each person is responsible for making her own reservation, or if rooming with a person, only one needs to make the reservation. The cost of the rooms at Farmstead for our group is as follows:
For up to 2 people Thursday \$109, Friday and Saturday \$119 plus 12% tax and fees. The total for 3 nights is \$388.64. We have 60 rooms reserved at this rate. The price is good up to 30 days prior. If you plan to have more than 2 in a room, please call Farmstead for rate.

UPDATE on rooms. Several members were told that no more rooms were available in our block, that is not true. I double checked with the event coordinator and we still have plenty of rooms in our block. Make sure when making your reservation you ask for the Mudsock Quilt Guild block. If you made a reservation that was not within our block, please call Farmstead and get a room within our block at the discounted rate.

Guest Room Cancellation Policy

Up to 30 days prior – no charge.

Less than 30 days more than 7 days prior – cancellation charge of 25% of the reservation.

7 days or less will be charged full price for room.

A free continental breakfast is included.

Check in time is 3:00P.M., checkout is 11:00 A.M.

The following month, all the blocks are displayed, and a raffle is held to determine who gets to take the blocks home for an instant quilt. Block Size: 6 ½" x 11" unfinished

Fabrics: Leaves – assorted greens

Pineapple – Your choice of bright popsicle or summer colors

Background – Solid white or white on white
