
Rose Garden Quilt Block Pattern

Make one block and add it to a fun spring quilt, or make several to create a table runner! Pattern makes one 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" block. Let's sew together! Use #sliceofpiquilts on Instagram!

Fabric & Supply Requirements

Flower Color A	(4) 3 1/2" squares
	(4) 2" squares
Flower Color B	(4) 3 1/2" squares
	(4) 2" squares
Stem/Leaves	(4) 2" x 3 1/4" rectangles
	(2) 1" x 6 1/2" rectangles
Background	(8) 2 1/2" squares
	(8) 1 1/4" squares
	(2) 3 1/4" x 4" rectangles (a)
	(2) 3 1/4" x 3 1/2" rectangles (b)
	(2) 3 1/4" x 2" rectangles (c)
	(2) 3 1/4" x 1 1/2" rectangles (d)





Let's begin!

- 1. Cut fabrics into the sizes and quantities in the chart above. This is a great block for using scraps!
- 2. Use a chalk pencil or disappearing ink pen to draw a diagonal line on the back of all Flower Color A and B 2" squares, Background 2 1/2" squares, and Background 1 1/4" squares.
- 3. Place a Flower Color A 2" square in one corner of a Flower Color B 3 1/2" square (right sides together). Sew on the diagonal line as shown below. Trim 1/4" away from seam line. Press. Repeat to make four.
- 4. Place a Background 2 1/2" square in the opposite corner of a unit created in step 3 (right sides together). Sew on the diagonal line as shown below. Trim 1/4" away from seam line. Press. Repeat with all four units.
- 5. Sew all four units created in step 4 together as shown below. (Use scant 1/4" seam.) Press seams as desired.
- 6. Repeat steps 3-5 with Flower Color B 2" squares, Flower Color A 3 1/2" squares, and Background 2 1/2" squares.

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7. Place two Background 1 1/4" squares in opposite corners of a Leaf 2" x 3 1/4" rectangle (right sides together) as shown below. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" away from seam line. Press. Repeat to make two.








8. Repeat step 7, but place the Background 1 1/4" squares in the other two corners to create a mirror image of the units created in step 7. Make two.








9. Lay out all block pieces as shown. (Use scant 1/4" to sew all remaining seams.)





- 10. Sew Background b, one leaf unit, and Background c together. Press towards background. Sew Background d, one leaf unit, and Background a together. Press towards background. Sew units to either side of a Stem 1" x 6 1/2" rectangle. Press towards stem. Repeat to make two units.
- 11. Sew flower unit created in steps 3-6 with a stem unit created in steps 7-9. Press as desired. Repeat to make two.
- 12. Sew two flowers together (one right side up and one upside down) to create block. Press as desired.
- 13. Block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
