Basket Quilt Block - Finished size 24 X 24

Fabric and cutting

You need a Light, Medium and a Dark fabrics. Also a color for the sashing rectangles.

***Can use 2 different medium fabrics for the A block and the C blocks

Block	Qty/Color	Cut Size
A	2 Medium squares – cut on the diagonal in half ONCE This will make the corner pieces of the block	12" X 12"
В	1 Light color square This will be for the corner	3 ½" X 3 ½"
С	4 Light, 4 Medium and 3 Dark squares –cut on the diagonal in half ONCE These triangles will be sewn together to make 7 - "C" square units. (5 medium and 2 dark sewn to light) Two of the Dark triangles will be attached to block "F" rectangle below. Two "C" Medium and Two Dark will be attached to block "D" unit to make 2 flying geese below.	3 7/8" X 3 7/8"
D	1 Light square – cut on the diagonal in half TWICE This is for the 2 Flying Geese blocks	7 ¼" X 7 ¼"
E	1 Light and 1 Dark square -cut on the diagonal in half ONCE One light is for the bottom corner of the basket or block One light and One Dark will be sewn together to make a square for the basket base.	67/8" X 6 7/8"
F	2 Light rectangles These rectangles will be attached to a Dark triangle from Block "C" cutting.	3 ½" X 9 ½"


G	Cut two rectangles for sides	2" X 21 1/2"
	These 2 rectangles are for the sashing of the block. Sew these two on the sides first then add block "H" rectangles to top and bottom.	
Н	Cut two rectangles for top and Bottom	2" X 24 ½"

Refer to Diagram 1 for steps 1-5 noting the color orientation. You may want to label each fabric until you assemble

- 1. Join together Dark and Light "C" triangles to make 2 squares.
- 2. Join together Medium and light "C" triangles to make 5 squares.
- 3. Join together a Medium and Dark triangle to each side of the "D" block to make (2) flying geese blocks.
- 4. Join together 2 block "C" Dark triangles to the sides of the block "F" rectangles to make (2).
- 5. Join together 1 Dark and 1 Light triangle from block "E" to form a square.

Now lay out all the sewn units and add the additional block "B" and block "E" to form the basket. Making sure to turn your blocks to match the diagram below. Noting the 2 flying geese blocks.

- 6. To complete the block, assemble all units as following Diagram 1
- 7. Once the basket is done, then you need to add Medium color block "A" to each side to make it a square. Try to center the Block "A" along the sides so the corners match up. Trim the block once added leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- 8. Now to add the Sashing rectangles to the sides. Add "G" to the sides first then add "H" to the top and bottom. Then you are all done.
