

MAY BOM Flying Flags

Block Finished Size: 11.5x11.5

Materials: Solid NAVY Blue, Solid White, Red print

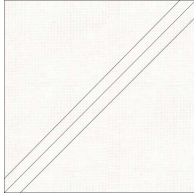
Rotary Cutting:

White: 2 squares 5"x5"
2 squares 4.5"x4.5"

Red: 2 squares 5"x5"

Navy: 1 strip 4.5"x12.5"

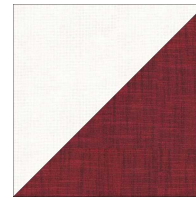
Piecing:



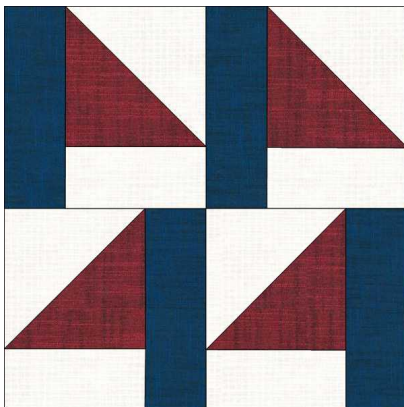
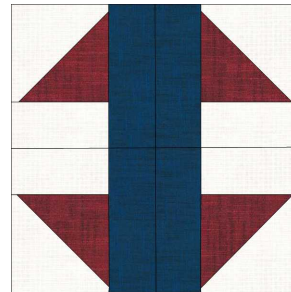
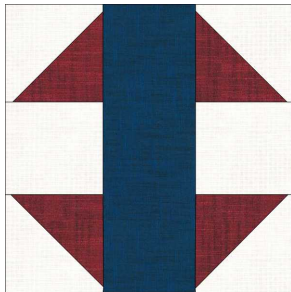
Use 1/4" seam allowances on all piecing.

HST: Draw Diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of the white fabric. Place the white and red 5" squares right sides together and sew a seam on both sides of the center line. Cut along the center line and press to the dark fabric.

Square up the HST to 4.5"x4.5" square.



Place a HST in the corners, taking care to position the patches with the red color to the inside of the block, and insert the white squares on the left and right columns. Seam the navy strip in-between the columns as shown below on left. Press to the dark fabric. Square up the block to 12"x12" and then cut through the centers on both the vertical and horizontal planes, as indicated below on right.



After you have cut the block into 4 sections, replace the top left and bottom right sections with each other to position the flags in the same orientation as it's neighbor, as shown below. Sew the neighbor blocks together and then combine the 2 rows.
