

Pot holders

For each set you will need:

1/2 yard of fabric for the main part of the potholder (back, pocket and binding)

A little over ½ yard is better if you want to do bias binding that will make binding easier

For log cabin style: 1 ½ inch wide strips of assorted fabrics- lights to darks

For scrappy style: scraps, strips and orphan pieces will work. Be creative!

Insulbrite about 12 x 18"

Walking foot for your sewing machine is very helpful

Cut:

2 8x14 pieces for pockets

2 8x10 pieces for backs

2 8x10 pieces of Insulbrite for lining

Layer back right side down, insulbrite with shiny side up, then baste together around outside edges

Sew strips/pieces to top using "flip and stitch/ quilt as you go" method until top is complete

Fold pocket in half wrong sides together and position on back of quilted piece with fold about 2 inches down from top

Baste around edges

Trim pot holder to about 7x9 inches

Trim corners to rounded shape

Bind as desired. Bias binding is easier to work with around the curves!

Use an extra piece of binding to make a loop to hang your potholder and attach to top

Admire your pretty potholders!!
