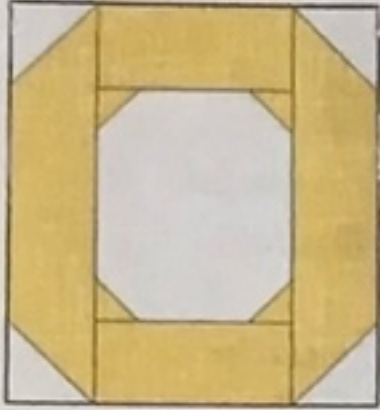


RINGS

A Missouri Star Block Video Tutorial <https://anyurl.com/xxxxxx>

Materials: 1 Twig, a 9"x11" piece of fabric, in a print, or 1 Fat Quarter for 4 blocks
1 5"x11" background color, white on white, or 1 Fat Quarter for 4 blocks

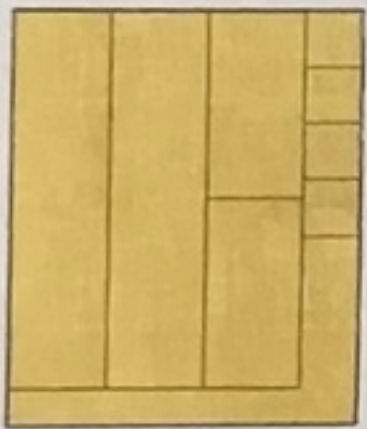


Block Size: Unfinished: 9"x10" Finished: 8.5"x9.5"

Kits will be available for piecing these blocks for Community Quilts. You can pick up a kit at meetings, the 2nd Monday of the month, or the Store Room on the 2nd Tuesday of the month. We will collect the blocks and sew them into tops.

Cutting Instructions:

Follow the diagrams shown for cutting out your fabric.

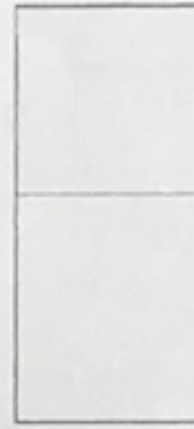


From print fabric cut:

(2) 2.5"x10" strips

(2) 2.5"x5" strips

(1) 1.5x6" strip, sub cut (4) 1.5"x1.5" sqs



From the background fabric cut:

(1) 5"x5" square, sub cut (4) 2.5" squares

(1) 5"x6" square

Block Construction: Note: press all seams to the print

Step 1: Snowball the corners of the 5"x6" piece with the 1.5"x1.5" squares. Mark a diagonal on the background, sew along the marked line. Trim off corners and press. Figure 1

Step 2: Add 2.5"x5" strips to the top and bottom of the center, press. Add the 2.5"x10" strips to the sides of the center, press. Figure 2 and 3

Step 3: Add the (4) 2.5"x2.5" squares to the corner of the block. Trim corners and press. Figure 4

Step 4: Square up block to 9"x10" unfinished.

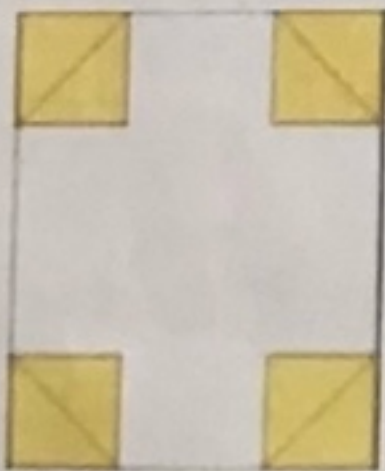

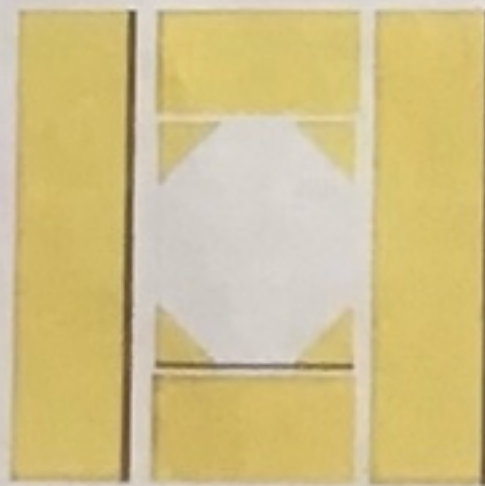

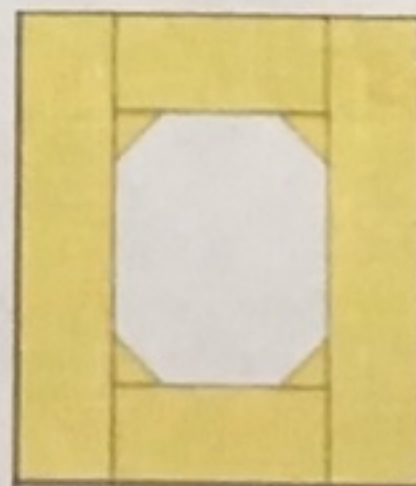

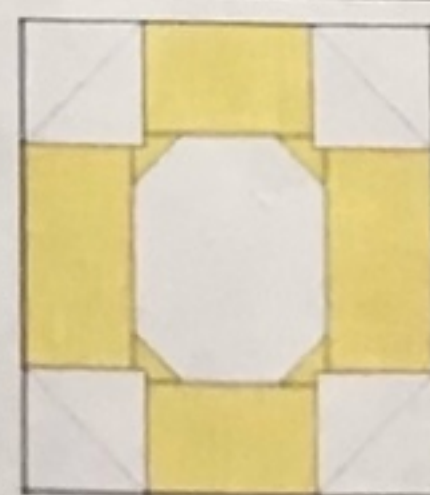
