

Block of the Month

"**Block of the Month**" (BOM) is a quick and easy way to learn new piecing techniques while contributing to member quilts. Each month, the BOM Committee selects a unique block pattern which they assemble at home and bring to the meeting. Everyone who wants to participate follows the same free pattern, using random fabrics with specified colorways. The following month, all the blocks are displayed, and a raffle is held to determine who gets to take the blocks home for an instant quilt. If enough members join in the fun, we might have 3-4 beneficiaries of the blocks.

For once it's great to be square! This month's BOM, the "Square in a Star" block lets you share a bit about who you are, what you enjoy, things that make you think of spring, a memory of springtime activities, or whatever things you can fussy cut to star in this block!

After making a block, take a picture and share it on Mudsock's Facebook with a paragraph that lets everyone learn a bit about who their fellow quilters are.

Here's an example:

While Spring is a fickle season when one day may be sunny and in the sixties and the next be a snowy day, I like the pansy peeking out of the center of my block since that is an early spring flower which seems like a little face peeking out with a smile. As soon as it's Spring, I begin to watch for those first containers of pansies that I can buy and take home to plant around our home. Spring with its time for planting pansies gives me a sense of joy when I dig into the earth and put those little flowers in the dirt, as well as hope when I anticipate warmth, sunshine, and the adventure ahead.

Now it's your turn to sew your own "Square in a Star" block and share it and a bit of who you are!
