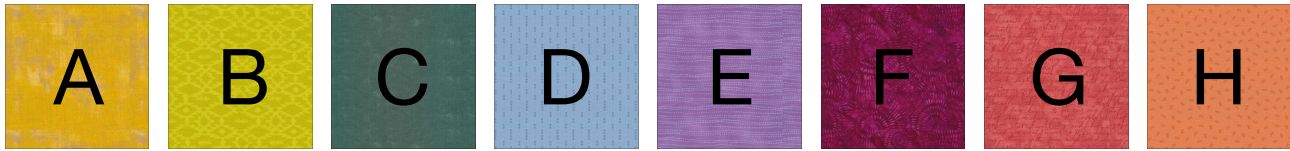


Fabric List:

List your fabrics A-H or 1-8 and keep a Key of their designation.



Instructions:

Follow the instructions from the Bricks Pattern up to the point you cut your 3.5" strip tube. When you begin your separation of the tube follow the patterns shown below to get the fabric placement you desire. Strip numbers read from upper left corner to upper right corner.

De-Construction:

Sample A: Cut....

- Strip 1 between Color F and G
- Strip 2 in the middle of Color G
- Strip 3 between Color G and H
- Strip 4 in the middle of Color H
- Strip 5 between Color H and A
- Strip 6 in the middle of Color A
- Strip 7 between Color H and A
- Strip 8 in the middle of Color H
- Strip 9 between Color G and H
- Strip 10 in the middle of Color G
- Strip 11 between Color F and G



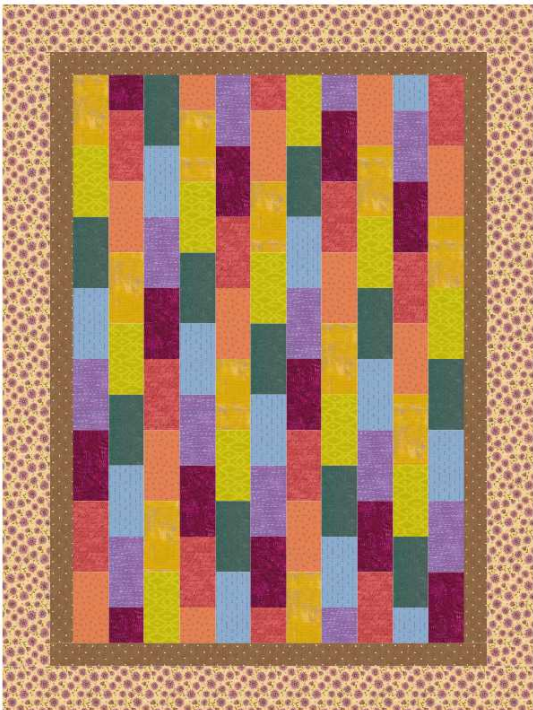
Sample B: Cut....

- Strip 1 between Color A and H
- Strip 2 in the middle of color A
- Strip 3 between Color A and H
- Strip 4 in the middle of color A
- Strip 5 between Color A and H
- Strip 6 in the middle of color A
- Strip 7 between Color A and H
- Strip 8 in the middle of color A
- Strip 9 between Color A and H
- Strip 10 in the middle of color A
- Strip 11 between Color A and H

Bricks Pattern Layout Options

Sample C: Cut

- Strip 1 between Color A and H
- Strip 2 in the middle of color H
- Strip 3 between Color H and G
- Strip 4 in the middle of color G
- Strip 5 between Color G and F
- Strip 6 in the middle of color F
- Strip 7 between Color F and E
- Strip 8 in the middle of color E
- Strip 9 between Color E and D
- Strip 10 in the middle of color D
- Strip 11 between Color D and C



Sample D: Cut

- Strip 1 between Color A and H
- Strip 2 in the middle of color F
- Strip 3 between Color B and C
- Strip 4 in the middle of color H
- Strip 5 between Color D and E
- Strip 6 in the middle of color G
- Strip 7 between Color B and A
- Strip 8 in the middle of color E
- Strip 9 between Color H and G
- Strip 10 in the middle of color D
- Strip 11 between Color G and F
