COMMITTEE REPORTS

- 1. Charity: Laurie
 - —155 quilts right now
 - —contractors have been measuring for remodeling, but we have been assured of 6 months notice if we need to move the storeroom
 - —reimbursement of \$50/quilt for batting and backing can be requested by members making a charity quilt
 - —Fall Creek fire station has a room perfect for workshops
 - -\$100 security deposit for the year is required
 - -dates can be scheduled for the entire year

 - —will present information at the July meeting
 - —actual gift exchange will take place in October, November, & December
 - —no specified monetary amount for the gifts
