**Charity Quilt Donations** 

The Mudsock Quilt Guild will support six designated charities in 2026, which are listed below.

A member of the Charity Committee will serve as the primary point of contact for each charity.

Donations to the selected charities will take place every other month – in January, March, May, July, September, and November.

Members may hold onto their finished quilts until the designated month for that charity and may turn in multiple quilts at once. Quilts turned in during the donation month will be given to that month's charity.

All quilts should be approximately 50x60" and be labeled with "Mudsock Quilt Guild, Fishers, Indiana".

A log will be maintained by the Charity Committee with the quilter's name and the number of quilts donated to each charity.

Designated charities will be encouraged to pick up quilts after the guild meeting for their designated month. The MQG point member for that charity will be responsible for arranging the pickup or delivery of the quilts.

For each charity, the MQG point member will invite a representative of that charity to attend the Guild meeting two (2) months before their donation month to give a 5-to-10-minute presentation to Guild members about their charity. For example, a representative from the Hope Center Indy will be invited to present at the January meeting, as the Hope Center is scheduled for quilt donations in March. If a speaker cannot attend, the MQG point member for that charity may provide the presentation.

Charities will be reviewed annually by the Charity Committee.

## **Batting**

A 120" roll of batting has been purchased and will be cut into 60"  $\times$  70" pieces, suitable for the Guild's recommended quilt size of 50"  $\times$  60". Batting will be provided through a swap system:

- ❖ When a member turns in a finished charity quilt (using their own batting), they will receive a 60" × 70" piece of batting in return.
- Batting will be available for swap at the monthly meetings, when a member turns in a charity quilt(s).
